



Photography and Video Policy

Greenwich Giants Baseball Club

As part of our Child Protection and Safeguarding policy Greenwich Giants Baseball Club will never post a photo or video alongside the name of the child/children featured in the photo/video.

If you see a photograph of your child(ren) that you would like removed from the website or social media, it is your responsibility to contact the Club to have it removed.

How we use photos and videos

Photographs and videos of children taken at Greenwich Giants Baseball Club sessions are for posting to the Greenwich Giants Baseball Club website, social media pages or printed on any advertising materials where appropriate. We do not post the children's names alongside their photographs.

There may be occasions where outside agencies related to Baseball photograph and video sessions at Greenwich Giants Baseball Club for training purposes. Prior to these occasions the club will inform Parents/Carers of the nature of the recording and provide adequate safeguarding measures, such as coloured wrist bands for those children without permission to be photographed or filmed.



Other safeguarding measures that we take:

- Obtain consent from Parents/Carers for photographs or videos to be taken or published by Greenwich Giants Baseball Club.
- Only take photographs or videos of children participating in sporting or club related activity.
- Ensure that children are appropriately dressed.
- We remind children that they have the right to tell an adult if they feel uncomfortable with any photography or video recordings.
- We will not force any child(ren) to take part in a photo or video recording even if parental consent has been given.

As a club, we frequently remind our parents, carers and staff of the importance of not sharing photos and videos taken at Greenwich Giants Baseball Club that may contain other people's children, without consent to do so from the Parent/Carer of the other featured child(ren). This includes their personal social media platforms as well as their wide community and support network.
